A reminder that weddings and funerals will be given priority for this and other church facilities, which may make it necessary to reschedule previously scheduled activities.

First Harvest Ministry - annual report

March 2023 arrived accompanied by the financial result of the First Harvest Project. Blessings flowed again as this year's corn crop produced an above-average yield, with the soybean crop producing an average yield. (High yields often cause lower prices.) Many thanks to supporters of supplies and transportation. Ray Detweiler hauled 2 tractor trailer loads of corn to Lancaster. Earl Weaver of Weavers Grain supplied an above-value bonus. The Growmark and Timac companies, which supply seed and fertilizer, gave the project a \$700 donation. Thank you for being the hands and feet of Jesus. Grain sales generated \$17,000 for available distribution:

- * \$12,000 designated for MCC, with a portion of that supporting the Damascus Goat Project
- * \$5,000 to support RamPacks, a local program serving the Pennridge School District
