

Mosaic Pathways Steering Team Update

The Mosaic Pathways Steering Team continues its work as part of the two-year <u>Mosaic</u> Pathways Process. Our team recently met with Mosaic leaders, Angela Moyer Walters, Roy Williams, and Steve Kriss to hear about their vision for the conference and ongoing communication between Mosaic and MCUSA. The strategic plan is taking shape in five focus areas: communication/transparency, clarity/identity, relationship building, leadership, and reconciliation. We are finalizing anchor statements and activities that will help us grow in each area and align with the conference's missional, intercultural, and formational priorities. The board will review the status of the plan at their May meeting. The team is working on both the plan and a recommendation regarding Mosaic's relationship with MCUSA for the November 2024 delegate assembly. Materials will be ready for the delegate preparation sessions which occur before assembly. Our team enjoys working together, laughs, has hard conversations, prays, and is committed to listening to each other and the Holy Spirit. I encourage you to continue to pray for this work, to sign up for the weekly Mosaic Newsletter, and to build relationships with Mosaic members in our 50+ congregations and 20+ Conference Related Ministries (CRMs).
